In The Gospel of Matthew

Matthew 1:1

The book of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, **the son of David**, the son of Abraham. *(what follows is the genealogy that backs this up with names)*

Matthew 1:20

"Joseph [Jesus' earthly dad], **son of David**, do not fear to take Mary as your wife..." *(announced by an angel)*

14x other times in the gospels this title is attributed to Jesus

In the Gospel of John

John 7:40-42

When they heard these words, some of the people said, "This really is the Prophet." Others said, "This is the Christ [anointed one]." But some said, "Is the Christ to come from Galilee? Has not the Scripture said that the Christ comes from **the offspring of David**, and comes from Bethlehem, the village where David was?"

In The Book of Revelation

Revelation 3:7

"The words of the holy one, the true one, who has **the keys of David**, who opens and no one will shut, who shuts and no one opens.

Revelation 5:5

"Weep no more; behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, **the Root of David**, has conquered, so that he can open the scroll and its seven seals."

Revelation 22:16

"I, Jesus, have sent my angel to testify to you about these things for the churches. I am the root and **the descendant of David**, the bright morning star."

In the Pauline Epistles

Romans 1:1-4

Paul, a servant of Christ Jesus, called to be an apostle, set apart for the gospel of God, which he promised beforehand through his prophets in the holy Scriptures, concerning his Son, who was **descended from David** according to the flesh and was declared to be the Son of God in power according to the Spirit of holiness by his resurrection from the dead, Jesus Christ our Lord,

2 Timothy 2:8

Remember Jesus Christ, risen from the dead, **the offspring of David**, as preached in my gospel,

8 Now, therefore, thus you shall say to my servant David, 'Thus says the LORD of hosts, I took you from the pasture, from following the sheep, that you should be prince over my people Israel. 9 And I have been with you wherever you went and have cut off all your enemies from before you. And I will make for you a great name, like the name of the great ones of the earth. 10 And I will appoint a place for my people Israel and will plant them, so that they may dwell in their own place and be disturbed no more. And violent men shall afflict them no more, as formerly, 11 from the time that I appointed judges over my people Israel. And I will give you rest from all your enemies. Moreover, the LORD declares to you that the LORD will make you a house. 12 When

your days are fulfilled and you lie down with your fathers, **I will raise up your offspring after you, who shall come from your body, and I will establish his kingdom.** 13 He shall build a house for my name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever. 14 I will be to him a father, and he shall be to me a son. When he commits iniquity, I will discipline him with the rod of men, with the stripes of the sons of men, 15 but my steadfast love will not depart from him, as I took it from Saul, whom I put away from before you. 16 And your house and your kingdom shall be made sure forever before me. Your throne shall be established forever.' "

2 Samuel 7:8-16 (ESV)

God's Promises to David Summarized

1. I will make your name great
2. I will appoint a place of safety and rest
3. I will bring stability of your kingly house or dynasty
4. One of your offspring will have everlasting kingdom
5. He will have a special relationship with God
